Your love story?

Tell us about your proposal.

Did you have a clear idea of what you wanted for your wedding?

Tell us about your dress?

Theme/colour scheme?

Live music at your reception?

The best advice you could give to brides-to-be?

Honeymoon?







There's something truly magical about a forest wedding ceremony ...

Was your proposal a surprise?

When I raised the topic of engagement Bryce would shrug it off nonchalantly, so when he proposed I really was surprised. We were engaged early March 2020 and then the pandemic hit, so we found our venue 7 months after getting engaged.

Did you have a clear idea of what you wanted for your big day?

I never made any final plans without running them past Bryce. I had never thought about my wedding day until we were engaged, not even as a little girl! I immersed myself in wedding magazines, TV shows and Pinterest and found a style we both liked.

What stood out about The Silver Sixpence?

The venue is near Dullstroom and Belfast along the N4 in a quiet country area, between rolling hills and trout farms. The venue is beautiful with incredibly well-maintained gardens; you can tell the owners take pride in their venue. You have the option of having your ceremony in a forest or in a chapel. "Black Friday" dress?

I refused to try on dresses that weren't on special so that I wouldn't get tempted! After trying on a few different styles I found the perfect dress for me. It was a mix between an A line and a Ballroom style.

Your bridesmaids wore black?

All 5 bridesmaids wore black floor-length dresses. As we didn't really have a colour palate, I decided on a colour that would complement them all. Black is elegant and timeless. I let each bridesmaid choose their own style as they all have different body types and would feel comfortable.

Forest ceremony?

The forest was one of the reasons we chose The Silver Sixpence as a venue. You have the option of a pine forest or a blue gum forest. 80. Due to the ever-changing lockdown regulations we kept the numbers under 100.

Your wedding songs?

"Close Your Eyes" by Michael Buble was my aisle song; then we chose "For You I Will" by Teddy Geiger for our first dance as it was also the first song Bryce played on guitar for me. The waltz with my Dad was to "Edelweiss" from The Sound Of Music – my favourite movie to watch with my late Gran. My paternal grandparents were from Austria so this was a special way to remember them.

Wedding budget-savers?

Have your wedding cake as part of your desserts to avoid spending extra. And, your guests won't notice if you don't have favours for them.

What cost more than you thought it would?

Photography and videography cost more than we expected, but we soon realised it involves a lot more than just pointing a camera and pressing a button. Good photographers and videographers are worth every cent.

Any surprises?

It rained the entire morning and I was convinced I would be getting married in the chapel and not the forest! But ,at 1pm the rain stopped and it was a beautiful afternoon.

Honeymoon?

We went to Thailand and as their restrictions relaxed we wanted to visit an extra city, so our wedding fund went towards seeing more. We explored Phuket and Bangkok. Beautiful beaches, an incredible culture, great food and the friendliest people!



Best moment of your big day?





What did you do about wedding gifts?


Our wedding invitation asked for money...in a subtle way! We bought some nice goodies for our home.

Any "oh no" moments?


