Tell us about how he proposed?

It was a cute intimate proposal at my mother in laws home.

We met with Pieter who showed us around, we then booked our wedding day for the 29th of October 2022 that same day.

The flowers, food, decor, and the DJ was all supplied by Pheasant Hill which was another reason why it was a no brainer to go with this exquisite French style venue, not having to deal with many different vendors really made my life much easier in the planning process as well as on the day.





I see that they have now built an amphitheatre behind the chapel, which was done about a month after our wedding, I think we should have a redo of the wedding just to have that in our photos! It is absolutely stunning.

Overall, our Pheasant Hill experience was an incredible one, the food was delicious, and the hospitality was world class. We look forward to going back there in the future for our wedding anniversary celebrations.

What do you both like doing for Valentine's day?





Tell us about how he proposed?

It was a Sunday morning, the 27th of June 2021, the morning of our two year 'dating' anniversary. We had planned to go visit the Sterkfontein Caves as an anniversary date for the day. I was in the kitchen, around 6:30 in the morning making our first cup of coffee for the day, and as I turned around to get the milk from the fridge, John was on his knee. I got such a fright but soon realised he was holding a ring. You can imagine the scene at the time... Me in my pajamas and gown, messy hair and all! John has always been a man of little words. He simply asked "Would you marry me?", and of course, my answer would always be "Yes!". I had been ready for him to pop the big question within a few months of knowing him. I just knew he was the perfect match for me. I was overjoyed and cried for about two hours, hardly being able to express any decent words...

Tell us about why you chose your venue?

We'd been visiting a lot of venues in and around Johannesburg for a few months, and we couldn't find anything that spoke to us, and more importantly, within our budget. We extended our search area and finally found a venue in Pretoria that we both loved! Yt Di Dorp Yt Venue is situated in a picturesque spot between the mountains, just outside the hustle and bustle of Pretoria city. We loved the beautiful chapel and the greenery and openness of the grounds. We were specifically looking for a venue to cater to our small intimate wedding, as we were planning to invite only a handful of guests. The wonderful thing about the venue was that the they would include everything we needed for our special day. Their package included the décor, flowers, music, the cake and catering. In the end, the wedding planners, Bianca and Leneé of La Bita Events, truly understood our vision for what we wanted in terms of the style of the day, and we were so happy that everything turned out exactly the way we dreamed it would be.

How did the planning go and how long did it take?

For months, on and off, we visited various venues. It took a while for us to actually set a date for our wedding as we wanted to confirm a venue first.

We got engaged on the 27th of June 2021, and found the venue on the 7th of August 2022. During that time, we had researched the type of style that we wanted for our wedding. When we decided that the Yt Di Dorp Yt venue was perfect for us, we finally set a date for the 29th of September 2022!





Our wedding would take place within seven weeks of finding the venue... The planning was finally set in motion. It seemed daunting to have so little time to arrange everything, but thankfully the venue took care of most of the planning. We already knew who we wanted to book for our photography and videography, so all that was left to do was arrange our invitations, attire, rings, and the hair and makeup.

Tell us more about your wedding dress?

I imported my dress on a small budget, with the hopes that it would be perfect. I was pleasantly surprised that my dress arrived within two weeks of ordering it, and that it fit perfectly! The top of my dress comprised of soft sequence detail with geometric patterned lace. The geometric detail was a nice touch, as our wedding style would include geometric elements. The style of the dress was an A-line, with the bottom layers in a beautiful bridal satin and soft tulle.

Who were your photographers?

Our photographer - Heidi, and videographer - Terence, is the team at Heidi-Mari Photography. We had used Heidi for our engagement photoshoot in November 2021, after I had been following her on social media for quite some time. Being a photographer myself, I was very specific about the style of photography that I preferred, and was so happy with how our engagement photos turned out. We actually finalised our wedding date based on Heidi's availability, as we just did not want anyone else to photograph our day! Heidi and Terrence did an outstanding job of capturing our love on lens on our wedding day.

Any Advice for planning?

The wedding planning doesn't have to be a daunting task. Try to find a venue that includes a lot of the things you could check off your planning list where you would normally have had to find a separate supplier for; for instance, the flowers, décor, music, etc. As a good start, have a clear vision of the style of your wedding, and stick to your vision to avoid being overwhelmed with too many decisions to make.

Lastly, enjoy the planning process! Before you know it, it will be the day of your wedding and all the planning stress will be replaced with beautiful memories of your special day!

Did you go on honeymoon and where?

We decided to go for a short honeymoon that would not be too far from home. We booked a few nights at the Rocky Aloe Lodge in Krugersdorp.

The lodge is situated on the boundary fence of the Krugersdorp Nature Reserve. Each morning, we woke up to the beautiful sound of lions roaring, and spent each late afternoon on the elevated look-out point watching the sun set over the reserve


Tell us about why you chose your venue?







We eventually stopped at the beachfront and went for a long stroll on the beach...and then everything changed.






