Tell us about your photographers?


Mighty fine, very professional. Eileen and Naledi, certainly made us feel comfortable



Not only is it an amazing way to support the sanctuary, but I also have a passion for bird photography, and we both have a love of birds and birding so it was so amazing to bring it all together into our big day! Not only did Heidi the barn owl deliver our rings but the center also brought two other birds, and during the canapes all our guest were able to interact with the birds from feeding, holding and learning about the birds and the center, it is such a cool and unique form of entertainment. for the guests plus we got to use them in our wedding photos which just added to the fairytale feeling that we were hoping for

Photography was done by Mellissa Brown and her husband Kelvin Brown from wandering pelican productions. Her story telling style of photography was exactly what we wanted and we just loved her eye and editing style! She was so good at directing us but also catching unscripted moments.


Did you go on honeymoon and where?




Tell us about your wedding dress?


Did you go on honeymoon and where?



Did you go on honeymoon and where?






What made you choose The Moon & Sixpence?

Tell us about your dress?


